### Highlights

**Friday Night** on your arrival (between the hours of 4-and-8:00 PM), LA County Fire will have the **Yogi Bear School House Earthquake Simulator** parked at registration. Please allow time to experience this demonstration. It will add to the experience of the Camporee and the events on Saturday afternoon. On **Saturday Afternoon** we will be staging a **Mock Disaster** event. The event is in the capable hands of several expert First Responders from: LA City Fire, LA Sheriffs, young Marines, Marines and Kern County Fire. Their teams will set up Triage and First Aid in a field-environment just like what would be in place immediately after a Real Emergency. You and your units will also feel first hand what it is like to go through an 8.0 Earthquake in the Quake Cottage Earthquake Simulator.

The Emergency Preparedness guidelines used in the event will follow requirements of the **First Aid and the Emergency Preparedness Merit badges**. Your scouts will be able to use this event to help with their rank advancement and meet some of the requirements of both merit badges.

The **Emergency Preparedness Award** (BSA National) requires training participation with an outside agency and this is a great way to complete this requirement.

**Remember to INVITE Your Troop's Eagle ScoutParents** to join us at Centennial Camporee 2008 and/or for the Emergency Preparedness Experience at the Second Annual Gathering of Eagle ScoutParents.
